Leddy's work examines the gendered experiences of colonialism, the reclamation of Indigenous parenting, Indigenous historical methods, and performance art as an expression of Indigenous feminist thought. She is the author of *Serpent River Resurgence: Confronting Uranium at Elliot Lake*, which was recently published by University of Toronto Press and her work has appeared in *Oral History Forum*, *Canadian Historical Review*, *Herizons*, and several edited collections.
